One building, two shops and premises over. This building has the date '1672' painted on it. C17 timber-framed building with plastered front. Tile-hung gable. Tiled roof. Sash windows with glazing bars. Two small C19 shop windows. Two storeys. Three windows.

Grade II

Cowdray Estate numbers which are not necessarily consecutive though the houses adjoin. One building. Early C19. Red brick and grey headers in Flemish bond. Slate roof. Glazing bars intact. Pair of doorways with projecting cornices on brackets. Two storeys and attic. Four windows. Three dormers.

Public House. This building occupies a prominent position in an angle between Rumbold's Hill and Wool Lane. C17 timber-framed building with plaster infilling and the first floor of the east front oversailing, ground floor rebuilt in coursed stone, now painted. Tiled roof. Casement windows. Two storeys. Three windows.

The north front has been refaced with stucco in the C19. Central chimney breast. Long niche on east side of it with pointed top and rectangular sunk panel above. Bay windows flanking the niches with corbels below them. Three windows. South front stone rubble with tile-hung gable.

One building, two shops. C17 or earlier timber-framed building with the timbering exposed on first floor of north wall. This oversails with painted brick infilling.  
Ground floor below refaced with stone rubble. The street front is plastered. Tiled roof. One window retains glazing bars. Others modern. Modern shop fronts. Two storeys. Two windows.

One building, now a house and shop or office. The exterior dates from the early C19 but the building is probably much earlier. Stuccoed front, very steeply-pitched hipped tiled roof. Small projecting bay on first floor. Glazing bars otherwise intact. Doorway in moulded architraves surround with projecting cornice. Modern shop front to north of this. South wall stone and tile-hung above. Two storeys. Two windows.

Grade II SU 8821 21/23

House. C17 building, refaced in the C18 and altered in the C19. Two gables containing attic windows. Ground floor stuccoed, above roughcast and modern timbering. Tiled roof. Sash windows without glazing bars. Doorway with pilasters and flat hood on brackets. Included for group value.

Grade II SU 8821 21/83

Public House. 1800 circa. Stuccoed. Hipped slate roof. Glazing bars intact. Ground floor windows have round-headed openings but are actually square-headed behind the openings.

Glazing bars intact. Doorway with engaged columns, pediment, semi-circular fanlight and door of six fielded panels. Carriage archway through ground floor at south end. Two storeys. Five windows.

Regency House**

House or shop. Early C19. Red brick. Modillion eaves cornice. Tiled roof. Glazing bars intact on first floor. Bay at north end of both floors. Modern shop fronts to south of this. Two storeys. Four windows.

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**RUMBOLD'S HILL West side  
Nos 413 and 416**

Grade II SU 8821 21/85

Cowdray Estate numbers which are not consecutive, though the houses adjoin. One building. Early C19. Red brick and grey headers in Flemish bond. Eaves cornice.

Tiled roof. Glazing bars intact. Two doorways with reeded pilasters and low rectangular fanlights and between them two small bays, probably shop windows originally, with a continuous cornice over the whole.
